



North Carolina state law (G.S. 130A-185) requires all dogs, cats, and ferrets over 4 months of age be vaccinated against rabies. This can be done at any veterinarian's office.

Havelock city ordinance (90.20) requires all dogs, cats, ferrets, and miniature pigs be licensed with the city. Licenses can be obtained at either City Hall or at the animal shelter. The application can also be found on www.havelocknc.us. The fee is \$10.00 per animal.

Havelock also has a leash law. This leash law also pertains to cats.
